In 2015 the Town Hall, believed to have been built in the 1760s, may be regarded as reaching its 250th anniversary. The appeal fund aims to acknowledge this significant event with an ambitious target of raising £250 for every year it has stood serving the town.

The council has decided to launch a direct appeal for funds.

Would you be prepared to make a personal or business donation, or to fund-raise with friends or a local organisation, with a target of £250 in mind?

All of those involved in the effort to secure a long and useful future for this wonderful building would be most grateful to hear that you would!

The fund will accumulate untouched, whilst the search goes on for major funders for the Renovation Project which received overwhelming public support earlier this year. The Heritage Lottery Fund will be the primary funder, but other lesser grants and this appeal fund will be needed to make up the balance of the total project costs. In the event of the grant applications failing, you will be consulted again about the proper use of the appeal fund.
